

From Your Pastor

This Easter, Bishop Robert Barron offers a reflection that is based on the three key lessons that he believes that we can take from what he calls the disquieting fact of the Resurrection. First, this world is not all that there is. The Resurrection shows us that God is up to something much greater that we can imagine. The world is then seen as a place leading to something much higher, more permanent and more splendid. Second, although the cross was seen as Rome's way of asserting its authority, now God reveals a new kind of power, the power of the Holy Spirit. Third, the path of salvation has been opened to everyone. Jesus, in going away from the Father by descending into the depths of pain, despair, alienation and God forsakenness, reached down to everyone, even those who had wandered far away from God. Bishop Barron tells us that in light of the Resurrection, the first Christians came to know that as far away as we can run from the Father, we can end up running into the arms of the Son. During this Easter season, let us reflect on these words and live their message as a people of hope.

On behalf of our Parish Staff, I extend to all of you God's Blessings, manifested in our risen Lord, Jesus Christ, in this Easter Season!

Henri Nouwen Speaks to us through his Letters

Henri writes to a Dutch friend about prayer and the spiritual life. This is Part I of his response. (taken from "Love, Henri: Letters on the Spiritual Life"):

Dear Dineke.

...I want to encourage you to develop an intimate relationship with Jesus. "God who seems far away" is somewhat of a problem! God is called all powerful, almighty, etc. Jesus, however, is "God with us," vulnerable, weak, broken, dependent and very approachable. Jesus is the God who needs us and asks us for our love: "Do you love me? Do you love me? Do you love me?" When you pray, look at Jesus, who says: "Come to me, all you who labor and are overburdened, and I will give you rest – for I am gentle and humble of heart"....
